


AMENDMENT NO. 17-8  
TO THE  
RULES AND REGULATIONS  
OF THE  
MEBA MEDICAL AND BENEFITS PLAN

At their November 29, 2017 meeting, the Trustees of the MEBA Medical and Benefits Plan amended the MEBA Medical and Benefits Plan Rules and Regulations (“Plan”) to include expenses for occupational therapy as a Covered Medical Expense as set forth below, effective January 1, 2017:

1. Article VI, Section 3(e) is amended to add a new subsection (35) to read as follows:
  - (35) occupational therapy prescribed and performed by a Licensed Qualified Provider for treatment of Dependent children under age 7, but not to exceed when combined with the physical therapy benefit set forth in Section 3(e)(9), a maximum of 30 visits per person annually.
