

US Coast Guard /Annual Physical Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Where can I get a US Coast Guard Physical?

A: Effective June 1, 2025, the MEBA Medical and Benefits Plan (“Plan”) has partnered with Concentra, a large national provider of employment physicals, to allow active and retired sailing participants who meet the Plan’s eligibility requirements to obtain one annual United States Coast Guard physical exam (with or without benzene labs) at a Concentra location.

Q: What other services are available at Concentra facilities?

A: Concentra facilities are authorized to complete the Benzene Exam, Drug Testing Collection, and Vaccinations needed for work-related voyages (including, but not limited to Hepatitis B, Hepatitis A, MMR Vaccine, Tdap Vaccine, Varicella, and Yellow Fever).

****Participants must obtain a pre-authorization from the Plan Office by calling (800) 811-6322 before receiving a US Coast Guard Physical or any other Concentra services.**

****To obtain a pre-authorization, please contact the Plan Office in advance of your appointment. Services obtained without prior authorization may not be eligible for coverage.**

Q: Will I receive a Fit for Duty and Benzene Certificate?

A: Concentra’s forms will verify whether you are “fit-for-duty”; however, Concentra does not automatically provide a fit-for-duty” certificate or a benzene certification in the same format previously provided by the Diagnostic Centers.

If you require those certifications, you may contact the Plan Office in Baltimore and obtain the forms that were previously used, Concentra will complete them for you in connection with your USCG exam.

Q: How often can I get an annual physical?

A: Regardless of whether an in-network or out-of-network provider is used, you and your dependents are entitled to an annual diagnostic examination not more than once in any calendar year. Active and retired sailing participants are eligible for one Concentra USCG physical and one diagnostic examination each calendar year.

Q: What procedures are covered as a part of your annual physical?

A: The following procedures are covered as part of your annual physical:
